

Privacy Policy

Collection and use of personal data

In order to receive the Gazet service, the user is asked to provide his/her name, an e-mail address and a mobile phone number. The user may also voluntarily provide additional information including personal, geographic and demographic data. In addition to the information collected from members, Gazet may from time to time also collect information about Gazet users from third party sources.

Gazet, info@gazet.se (Gazet) will act as Controller of the personal data, i.e. be responsible for determining the purposes and means of the collection and processing of personal data. Gazet operates a strict opt-in only policy and complies with the standards, procedures and requirements laid down by European Community Directive 95/46 (the Data Protection Directive) and its implementing provisions, to ensure that the personal information you provide is kept secure and is managed and processed fairly and lawfully.

The personal data collected in connection with the Gazet service will be processed by Gazet and other companies within the Gazet group for purposes of administering and providing any service(s) subscribed to by the user and to ensure that users receive the most relevant and personalized targeted offers from Gazet. The personal data may be used for marketing purposes by Gazet, other companies within the Gazet company group or by other companies with which the group cooperates. This includes the use, by Gazet, other companies within the Gazet company group, of personal contact information for the purpose of sending newsletters, advertisements and other commercial messages to the user's personal e-mail address or mobile phone, if the user has consented to such use when providing the contact information.

A third party company handles mailings such as competitions, offers and discounts, relevant for the members, on Gazet's behalf. This may however change at any date. For updated information, e-mail questions to info@gazet.se

The personal data collected may be stored and processed within the European Union or in any other country where Gazet conducts activities.

Reviewing or Modifying User Information or Terminating Service

Users may choose at any time to review, modify or permanently remove all personal data and other information stored by Gazet concerning the user by contacting Gazet at info@Gazet.se.

The user may also at any time unsubscribe to any newsletters, advertisements or other commercial messages sent to his/her e-mail address or mobile phone and request that his/her contact information no longer be used for marketing purposes. Information on how to make such a request is found on Gazet's webpage and in each e-mail or other message sent to the user by Gazet. However, following such a request Gazet may still send such messages to the user as may be necessary in order to perform or administer a service to which the user has subscribed.
